

ORDINANCE NO. 445

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WYOMING, IOWA, 2002, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO SEWER RATES.

Be It Enacted by the City Council of the City of Wyoming, Iowa:

Section 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Chapter 99, Section 02 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Wyoming, Iowa, 2002, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

99.02 RATE. Each customer shall pay sewer service charges for the use of and for the service supplied by the municipal sanitary sewer system based upon the amount of water consumed as follows:

1. First 1,000 gallons or lesser amount per month @ \$70.00 per month (minimum bill).
2. All over 1,000 gallons per month @ \$10.00 per 1,000 gallons.

Non-metered service, a private water source, would be billed by the size of the household as follows:

1 person	\$ 75.00
2 people	\$ 85.00
3 people	\$105.00
4 people	\$115.00
5 people	\$125.00
6 people	\$135.00
7 people	\$145.00
8 people	\$155.00

3. Future Rates. The monthly per gallon rate set out in 99.02 shall be adjusted annually as follows: On July 1, 2024, all sewer rates shall be increased by 2.0% over the rates established in subsection 1 and 2 of this section, which rates will take effect until June 30, 2024. On each July 1 thereafter, said sewer rates shall be increased by 2.0% over the rates in effect during the preceding year.

Section 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of the ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
