Swimming Pool Fill – The City allows for a sewer credit based on the water consumption needed to fill the pool. Stop in the City Hall office to pick up a pool fill request form before you fill. This is a once-a-year credit.

The flushing of water hydrants has begun. City maintenance staff will be flushing hydrants on the third Monday and Tuesday of every month, weather permitting. Please note: if you experience discoloration, you need to run your water until it is clear.

Annual Grass and Weed Abatement Notice: Grasses, weeds, brush, dense growth shall be kept at a maximum of 6 (six) inches in residential, business, and industrial property from May 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup>. **No other notice will be given** before the City will abate the notice and shall assess all costs incurred to the property.

Open burning of yard waste only is allowed March 15<sup>th</sup> to June 1<sup>st</sup>. All fires must be out by dark.

Golf carts may be operated upon the streets of the City by persons possessing a valid driver's license and proof of insurance. Golf carts may be operated on city streets only between sunrise and sunset. No golf cart shall carry more passengers than the golf cart is designed for.

Ordinance 55.06 – Dogs At Large It is unlawful for any owner to allow an animal to run at large within the corporate limits of the City.

Ordinance 55.07 Damage or Interference It is unlawful for the owner of an animal to allow or permit such animal to pass upon the premises of another thereby causing damage to, or interference with, the premises.

Ordinance 55.08 Annoyance or Disturbance It is unlawful for the owner of a dog to allow or permit such dog to cause serious annoyance or disturbance to any person or persons by frequent and habitual howling, yelping, barking, or otherwise; or, by running after or chasing persons, bicycles, automobiles or other vehicles.

Ordinance 55.09 Barking Dogs All complaints concerning barking dogs shall be referred to the City Clerk's office. The complainant shall fill out a written complaint and file it with the City Clerk's office. The City Clerk shall notify the owner of the dog of the registration of the complaint. Any dog having 3 complaints lodged against it within seven (7) days may be ordered permanently removed from the City by the City Council following hearing after appropriate notice and opportunity to be heard are given to the dog's owner. Any action taken by the City Council removing a dog from the City shall be enforced by the law enforcement officer for the City.
