March 18, 1937: Before Orval Buckingham closed up his John Deere dealership for the night Monday, he had done \$4,933 worth of business. He had sold three tractors, a 22-36 threshing machine, two tractor plows, two disc harrows, a tractor cultivator and a set of tractor tires.

March 17, 1927: Among the shippers from this station last week was F.E. Sarby from near Olin who shipped a car of hogs to Boston.

March 21,1907: Oil prospecting is taking on a lively aspect at Maquoketa with the arrival of two drilling outfits.
