At Midland, we are approaching teaching and learning through Universal Design which supports *all students* with the accommodations and services they need in order to be successful. This has proved effective as our students with IEPs **MET** their targeted status in the area of math! Our students with IEPs from Grade 3rd - 11th surpassed the state average for **growth** in math!

### **Iowa Association of School Boards**

Several board members and I attended training in Des Moines to learn how to work more effectively as a school board. We walked away with good ideas and strategies to support Midland CSD. Ms. Christiansen, along with students from her Food Processing Class, were also a part of the event. The students did an amazing job articulating the lessons learned, the vision for the class as well as sharing tasty treats they had made in class with attendees.


