Open burning of yard waste is permitted from Sept 15th through December 1st. Fires MUST be out by dark. Burning of any trash, leaves, rubbish or other combustible material in any curb and gutter (culverts included) or on any paved or surfaced street or alley IS PROHIBITED. To prevent plugging of storm culverts, do not put yard waste into storm or street ditches. There is no dumping allowed in Little Bear Creek.
