## **ORDINANCE NO. 440**

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF WYOMING, IOWA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WYOMING, IOWA:

SECTION 1. <u>26.01 WYOMING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION</u> <u>CREATED</u>.

There is hereby created a Commission composed of five (5) members and the acting Clerk of the City of Wyoming, who shall be a non-voting member of the Commission. The appointed members shall serve on the Economic Development Commission for staggered two-year terms. All members are to be appointed by the Mayor with approval of the Council. The five members will be appointed January 2023, with three appointed to two year terms, and two appointed to one year terms. After the initial appointments, all terms will be for two years.

SECTION 2. <u>26.02 APPPROPRIATION AND POWERS.</u> The Economic Development Commission will pursue economic growth in the City, subject to advice, guidance, and direction of the City Council. The Commission shall have no power to bind the City or City Council.

26.02 (1) To receive funds as may be allotted to it by the Council. Such funds shall be maintained in a special fund in the office of the Clerk with expenditures of the funds to be made by the Clerk upon authorization and direction of the Commission made in a scheduled and public noticed meeting. The Commission shall also have the power to receive donated funds and to otherwise raise funds by solicitation and contribution.

26.02 (2) To make recommendations to the Council, from time to time, as deemed appropriate by the Commission.

26.02 (3) To have such other powers and perform such other duties as the Council may from time to time provide and direct.

SECTION 3. <u>26.03</u> <u>REPORTS.</u> The Economic Development Commission shall file reports outlining its efforts and activity with the City Clerk at least quarterly and at such other time as requested by the Mayor and/or City Council.

SECTION 4. <u>26.04 VACANCIES</u>. If any vacancy exists on the Commission caused by resignation, or otherwise, a successor for the reside of the term shall be appointed in the same manner as the original appointee.

SECTION 5. <u>26.05 COMPENSATION</u>. All members of the Commission shall serve without compensation, except their actual expenses, which shall be subject to the approval of the Council.

SECTION 6. <u>REPEALER</u>. All ordinances parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. <u>SEVERABILITY CLAUSE</u>. If any section, provision, or part of the ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 8. <u>WHEN EFFECTIVE</u>. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and posting as provided by law.
