Looking Back:

In 1856, a most remarkable machine, called the centrifugal separator, was invented, and commercial creameries soon became part of the great industrial growth of America. Prior to this, cream was obtained by letting the milk stand in a container until the cream rose to the top and was skimmed off. The separator extracted more cream in less time. Farmers separated their milk mechanically and sold the cream to their local creameries for butter churning. The old methods recovered about 30% of the cream. The separator got it all. Cream was the cash crop, and the skim milk was used to feed livestock. Mixed with oats it fermented and made a good hog feed.

In 1881, Diamond Creameries of Monticello had 9 facilities. In 1887, Jones County was first in the state with 41 creameries. By 1895, it had 18. Among the many creameries were Center Junction, Amber, Anamosa, and Monticello.
